- -Haute-Loire




It is also classified by Lonely Planet as the 6th region best to visit in the world.

- The highest volcano is called Le Sancy, and the most famous is Le Puy-de-Dôme.




Where are we? In Issoire!

Issoire is a small town where life is good, in the center of the region, and just south of the largest city of Auvergne: Clermont-Ferrand.








Our School: Institution Sévigné Saint Louis

- +32 members of the personal staff: the headmaster, supervisors, and a lot of others...










Quarry of volcanic rocks at « Puy de la Vache
