Lesson on volcanoes or earthquakes

1. The Organizer of the Competition is the Spanish team from Nueva Isleta-Toni Gallardo School of the Erasmus+ project stated below at #2., according to the work programme established by the General Coordination from Poland.
2. The competition is funded by the Erasmus + project : **Trail of extinct and active volcanoes, earthquakes through Europe from the grant 2015-1-PL01-KA219-016727**
3. People authorized to provide detailed information about the competition are Salvador Ledesma Machado (saanlema@yahoo.es) and Guillermo Montesdeoca (montesdeoca73@hotmail.com).
4. The topic of the contest is educational proposals related to volcanism, earthquakes, volcanoes in Spain, Europe and the rest of the world for secondary education students.
5. The purpose of the project and the contest is:
 - getting to know about the formation of volcanoes;
 - enrichment of knowledge concerning the formation of the Earth;
 - understanding of volcanic phenomena on Earth;
 - understanding the causes of earthquakes, ways of monitoring earthquakes;
 - gain knowledge of their region volcanoes, volcanoes in the world;
 - gain knowledge about the impact of volcanoes on the environment and people.
6. The competition is open to teachers from all kinds of secondary education in Spain.
7. Participants must be secondary education teachers who can submit a lesson of their own not subject to any copyright regarding the topic of the competition.
8. The competition will end on 31.03.2016.
9. The Competition Organizer will resolve situations not covered by the rules.

II. RULES FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE CONTEST

1. Participation in the contest is free of charge.
2. Competition Participant may be secondary school teacher
3. The designed lesson must be an original work with objectives, contents, evaluation criteria and activities.
4. Taking part in the contest means the total acceptance of its rules. The winner grants copyrights of its work for the educational purposes of the project. The project will acknowledge the authorship of the winner participant regarding their work.
5. Electronic versions of the lessons should be saved in .pdf and .doc at A4 size. The file should contain the author's data (first and last name, phone number, e-mail, name and address of school).
6. The entries should be sent to both the following e-mail addresses: saanlema@yahoo.es and montesdeoca73@hotmail.com, by the deadline of 31.03.2016.
7. The organizer reserves the right to select lessons, if it is believed they violate the rights of third parties, they are socially inappropriate, or contain material protected by exclusive rights (eg. Copyrights) without the consent of the beneficiaries.

III. EVALUATION CRITERIA AND RULES FOR THE GRANTING OF AWARDS

1. The lesson plan should be innovative, use various methods of encouraging students. The scope of the competition is that it can be applied in a classroom.
2. The competition will be judged by a jury appointed by the organizer.
3. The main evaluation criteria are:
 - Relevance to the topic,
 - Originality,
 - Educational value,
 - Possibility to use during classes at school.

4. The lesson proposals can be in Spanish, English or both. Being in both languages will be positively considered.

5. There will be one winner. The contest can be declared void.

6. The contest organizer provides the prize.

7. In cases of doubt or dispute regarding the winner or the granting of a special prize the Organizer will ultimately resolve.

8. Decisions taken by the Jury are final and legally binding on all participants in the contest.

9. The winner will be announce the 15th of April 2016

IV. COPYRIGHT AND PRIVACY

1. The winner will grant to the Organizer the right over their work for non-profit educational purposes.

2. Personal data will be subject to the Spanish law in effect.

V. PRIZE

1. The prize will consist of an electronic device (a tablet).

VI. FINAL PROVISIONS

1. The organizer reserves the right to change the Rules of the competition. The new rules apply from the date of publication.
